ALERT Luton Airport Expansion

Do You know that:

- A planning application for Luton Airport's Phase I expansion is due to be submitted within the next few weeks.
 - This application will, in itself, allow growth from 9.2 to circa **15 million** passengers per year.
- Luton Borough Council (LBC) has a very significant financial interest in seeing the planning application approved, and has sole power to approve it.
 - As the landowner, LBC gets a royalty for every passenger arriving and departing.
- Unless the planning application is 'called-in' * by the Office of the Deputy Prime Minister (ODPM), then the Phase I application will almost certainly succeed. This will pave the way for Phase 2, the construction of a second, 3,000 metre, runway taking jumbo jets and allowing growth to circa 30 million passengers per year.
- If both runways are used the total number of passengers could grow to 40-50 million per year.

[*called-in: when the First Secretary of State considers it necessary to call in a planning application to determine himself, instead of leaving the decision to the local planning authority.]
